Also remember with the new year, we will be sending out a notification for renewal of your membership. There is no action required now, just want everyone to be aware.

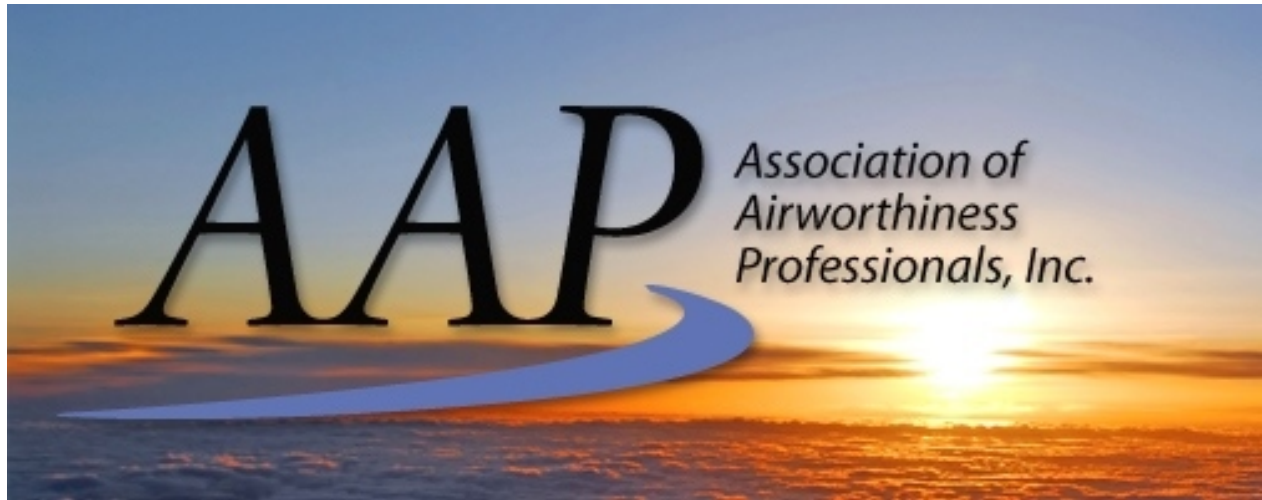
