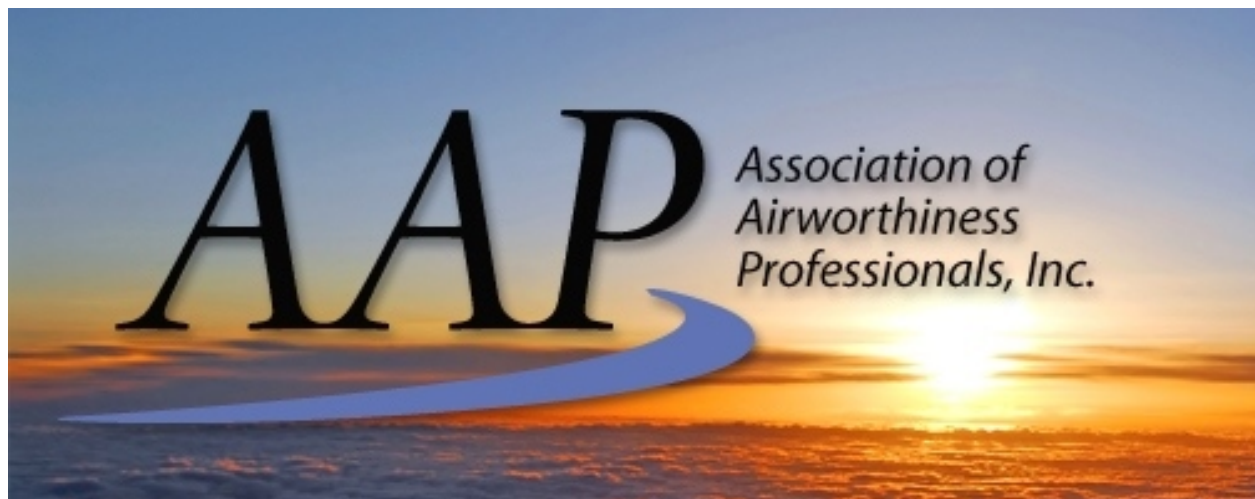


Reports were made by the Treasurer, Membership, Technical Publications, and Ethics Committee.
